Extensions

IRS and GA

You must request an extension of time to file if you want us to file an extension for you.
You can e-mail or upload your request with your business and/or individual name(s) to us.

Business Tax Returns are due March 15, 2019.

Personal Tax Returns are due April 15, 2019.

Tax Returns are considered late after their due date and you may be penalized by the IRS and/or State for filing late without an extension.

There is only 1 extension allowed per Business Tax Returns, per Tax Year.

There is only 1 extension allowed per Individual (personal) Tax Returns, per Tax Year.

Business Extensions are due September 16, 2019.

Personal Tax Returns Extensions are due October 15, 2019.

Remember, this is an extension of time to file until September 16 for Business Returns OR October 15 for Individual Returns; **this is not an extension of time to pay.**

The IRS and/or state will apply interest and penalties if you owe taxes and pay them after April 15th. If you anticipate owing, your taxes due should be estimated and a pre-payment should be made before April 15th.
